The standards for this course are outlined by the California Department of Education. Curriculum (Standards in parentheses)

Our focus this year will include the Founding of the Nation (8.1), the U.S. Constitution (8.2), American Political System (8.3), American Ideals (8.4), Early Republic & Foreign Policy (8.5), American People of the North, South, and West (8.6, 8.7, & 8.8), Abolition of Slavery (8.9), Civil War (8.10), Reconstruction (8.11), and the Industrial Revolution (8.12)

Classroom Rules

- 2. Raise your hand and wait to be recognized when asking a question or contributing to class discussion.

- 1. Homework and class work assignments are written on the board everyday. Each student is responsible for writing the assignments down in their planner.
- 2. Each student is responsible for *completing and submitting* all assignments on their due dates.
- 3. Each student is responsible for completing any missing assignments due to absence or illness. I will not seek out students with their missing work.
- 4. All assignments will be readily available. Just ask for them at appropriate times.
- 5. Homework is due *every Friday*, unless otherwise specified.
